





Service Charter of Rights

	<p>Our laws need to respect the rights of people with disability.</p> <p>You should be included in community life.</p> <p>You have the same rights as everyone.</p>
	<p>What are your rights?</p>
	<p>You should be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• safe in your home and anywhere else• treated with respect• part of your cultural community
	<p>You should be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• participate in your religion• express your sexuality• communicate in your family's language
	<p>You should be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• make complaints• able to say you want to go to another provider
	<p>You can tell us what you want and when you want it.</p> <p>You can tell us what type of worker you want.</p> <p>You can tell us how you want things done.</p> <p>We will always follow your instructions, unless we feel that you may get hurt then we will talk to you or your trusted person about the risk.</p>
